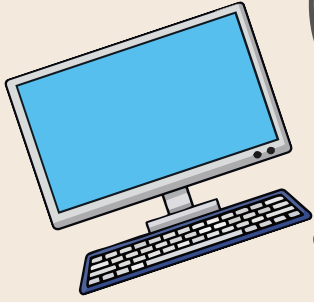


Computing
