LIVING IN THE WIDER WORLD

- Helps children understand their role within school, their community and the wider world.
- Develops financial awareness and decision-making skills to prepare children for future life.
- Encourages children to celebrate diversity, value equality and become responsible, active citizens.

RELATIONSHIPS

- Encourages children to build positive, respectful and healthy relationships with others.
- Develops empathy, kindness and effective communication, helping children resolve disagreements appropriately.
- Teaches children how to recognise safe and unsafe situations, including online, and where to seek help if they are worried.

HEALTH AND WELLBEING

- Supports children to develop positive mental health, resilience and emotional wellbeing.
- Teaches children how to make safe, healthy and informed choices about their physical and emotional health.
