Favourite subject: Science especially biology.

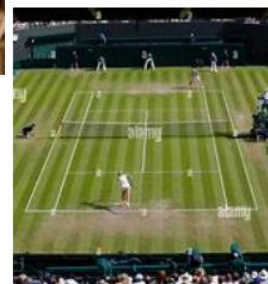
Animal: Domestic Rats (I used to have two).
