### You told us...

that you are concerned about the safety of the children due to a small number of parents parking illegally.

### Our response...

We fully agree with you. We continue to communicate our expectations about parking around the school at the beginning and end of the day. Just like you, it continues to sadden and frustrate us that there is still a small number of parents/carers who continue to park in breach of the law with little regard to this or what the school is trying to achieve. We do continue to challenge parking where possible and are sure many of you have seen that a member of the team now stands on the other side of Clockhouse Lane each morning and evening. Sadly, we cannot be everywhere and a small number of parents simply ignore our requests. We can only try. Thanks to all those who take this seriously.

### You asked us...

to think about the way we are celebrating different religions to make it more equitable.

### Our response...

Our Religious Education curriculum is very prescriptive. Unlike other areas of the curriculum, we have very little autonomy over what the children study and when, as we have to follow the agreed syllabus. By the end of Year 6, all religions are studied. We will be looking into how religious festivals are celebrated.

98% of you agree that the school is well led and managed.

### A small number of you asked us...

to once again review the school dinner situation, with varying views being fed back to us about this.

### Our response...

Whilst we do take on board your views and thoughts, a lot of what you ask us is beyond our control as the kitchen is not run by the school; it is run by the Local Authority. This means that we have no say over what is on the menu, how often it is changed, and how regularly it is reviewed. Having said this, where appropriate, we do provide feedback, including the feedback you give to us.

97% of you agree that the school keeps your child safe and that your child feels safe.

### Some of you said...

that you would like to see more clubs for the children each week and more trips out of school.

### Our response...

We fully recognise the importance of our wider curriculum offer and how important these experiences are for the children. However, it is a balance. It is important to remember that we do not charge for any clubs currently, as our staff give up their time to run these for the children for free. We are also mindful of the cost of school trips. Sadly, the school makes a loss on every single school trip we organise for the children. While this does not stop us from going on the trip, it is a consideration we have to bear in mind.
