You told us...!

Thank you to all those who completed our most recent questionnaire. We received 210 responses out of a parent population of over 1000.

Read on to find out about what you told us!

You told us...

That School Cloud and the club allocation meant that a small number of children did not get any clubs they wanted.

Our response...

We also did not think School Cloud was the best or most practical solution for us as a school. Therefore we have taken the decision this year to go back to the previous method where you will be asked to complete a paper form. This will be coming out in the near future.

100% of you agree that your child feels happy at Clockhouse.

You asked us...

If all children could eat in 'Time to Eat' rather than those having packed lunches eat in their classroom.

'I love being a part of the Clockhouse family. That is really what it feels like as a parent. The link between home and school is seamless. Communication is frequent and clear and if you have a question you always get an answer'

Our response...

97% of you agree that your child feels safe at school. As much as we would like this to, it is just not possible. We have approximately 700 children eating at lunchtime and over 400 of these have a school dinner. Time to Eat holds a maximum of 180 children. In order to get the children through in the allocated time, and it not impact on curriculum time we have no choice but to do it in this way.

'I am thankful to the school as they helped my child to settle in and feel welcome coming from a different country and continent altogether.'

A small number of you said...

There needs to be a greater focus on the behaviour of a small number of children and how they are supported.

Our response...

We understand from a parents / carers perspective it could be seen that things are not dealt with as others feel they should be. We can assure you all behaviour is managed in line with our school policy. We are also pleased to inform you that this year one of our focus areas will be developing the children's behaviour for learning and their learning behaviours.

You said...

You would like the school to continue to ensure well-being is prioritised along with academic development.

'My daughter has really loved being at school and I'm so impressed with how much she has learnt. Thankyou to her teachers and everyone who's involved to make her first year very enjoyable'
