


You Told Us...

Thank you to those who completed out recent questionnaire. We received 158 responses out of a parent population of over 1000. Read on to find out about what you told us!

Our response...

We fully appreciate there are less clubs than normal this year. This is for 2 reasons. Firstly, Miss Macdonald, who ran many sports clubs is currently on maternity leave. Secondly a number of staff now give up their time to enrich the play experience for the children at lunchtime which means the children enjoy a better time outside. It is also important to remember that we do not charge for any clubs currently, although this is something we could look into to increase the opportunities for the children. On a positive note, we are hopeful that Miss Macdonald will soon return - so watch this space for more sports clubs coming your way.
