Uniform for September

Please be aware that if you wish to have uniform delivered to school for September, this must be ordered no later than **4th July**. After this date, orders can still be made but will need to be delivered to your home. This will cost of £3.95 or free for orders over £50.00. Should you want uniform for September, orders **MUST** be made by **Monday 31st July**. Online ordering will resume at some point in September. Please be aware we do not have stock in school so if you wish to purchase brand new uniform, you will need to use this facility.

Thank you to all those who are supporting our efforts to ensure children are wearing the right PE kit, school PE kit is an expectation and we do ask that this is adhered to, so please ensure the children have the appropriate kit ready. Also, we continue to have a number of children wearing jewellery that is not acceptable for school.

Can I please remind you that jewellery is not permitted for safety reasons. It is Local Authority policy that children do not take part in P.E. if they are wearing earrings. As P.E. is compulsory part of the curriculum, please ensure that earrings are always removed on PE days.

2. ORDERING GUIDE

Under normal circumstances we aim for all orders to be sent out within 10-15 working days. During our busier periods (especially over the summer) or if anything unexpected occurs, it can take longer, so please allow us some extra time to get your order to you.

A Few Reminders

Uniform:

Thank you so much to all parents who work with the school and ensure that their children come to school looking so smart, and dressed in correct school uniform. Please can I remind you that the school uniform is black flat shoes, not sandals. As part of Health and Safety, please ensure that long hair of both boys and girls is tied back. This does help prevent the spread of head lice amongst children. Please can I also remind you that the children are not permitted to wear nail varnish.

As it gets warmer, please do send the children into school with water bottles, a hat (if needed) and with sun cream on - the children will go outside in the hot weather.

Please do not forget that we now have our very own No Cost Uniform Shop which is open regularly. Please do take the time to pop in and have a look. Should you need to access the shop at other time, please do not hesitate to ask.

Playground Equipment:

As tempting as I know it is for children to play on the playground equipment, we ask that you support the school in not allowing children to climb on playground equipment before and after school. The equipment is for school use only under the supervision of school staff. Unfortunately accidents do occur. As a result of misuse by younger siblings, the school cannot take responsibility for this.

Scooters and Bikes:

Please can we also remind you that scooters and bikes should not be ridden on the school site at the start and end of the day due to the hazard this presents. Thank you in advance for your understanding and support.

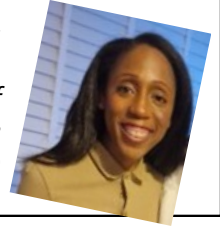
Parking
