Fantastic News!

We end the year in such a positive place with the best academic outcomes we have ever had and we are so proud of every single child. They have worked so hard this year and this is certainly shown in the progress that they have made -

- Reception Good Level of Development - 75%
- Year 1 Phonics Screening Check - 89%
- Year 4 Multiplication Check (score 22+/25) - 87%
- Year 6 Reading (Expected Standard +) - 80%
- Year 6 Writing (Expected Standard +) - 80%
- Year 6 Maths (Expected Standard +) - 87%
- Year 6 Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (Expected Standard +) - 83%
- Year 6 Reading, Writing and Maths (Expected Standard +) - 76%

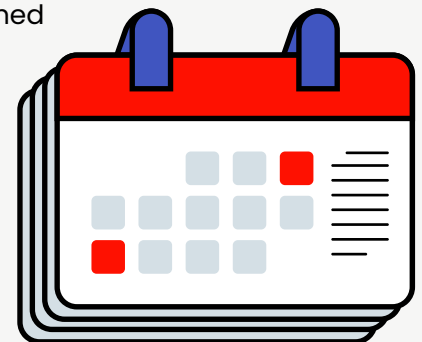
